#### Alsace

- 6 Gewürztraminer Reserve, Gustave Lorentz 2005/6 £27.00  
Rose petals, exocotic fruits and spices at the nose. Good structure, very little residual sugar and long finish. A wonderful wine to compliment rich food (smoked fish, spicy oriental cuisine, strong cheese, desserts).

#### Loire

- 7 Sancerre, Paul Thomas, Chavignol 2006 £28.00  
From vineyards on the prime site of the hill opposite the village of Chavignol, vinified under the watchful eye of Arnaud Bourgeois, this is quintessential Sancerre. Superb.
- 8 Half Bottle £15.00
- 9 Muscadet Sevre et Maine, Domaine de la Brouardiere 2006 £20.00  
A high quality Muscadet which has matured for two or three months on the fermentation lees, giving it a richer flavour with a dry finish. Excellent with sea-food.

#### Burgundy

- 10 Macon Blanc Villages, Henry Fessy 2006 £17.00  
From the best village sites around Macon, this ripe, almost buttery white wine is made from the Chardonnay grape.
- 11 Petit Chablis, Moreau et Fils 2006 £22.00  
An excellent value Chablis with dry, clean and slightly steely flavours typical of wines from that region.
- 12 Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons, Moreau et Fils 2006 £30.00  
A fine and elegant Chablis, with appealing aromas and round, soft tropical and delicate citrus fruit flavours on the palate.

#### Bordeaux/Rhone Valley

- 13 Crozes-Hermitage, Les Pends, Rhone Valley 2006 £27.00  
Delicious, light, almost peachy fruit make this classic Northern Rhone an excellent partner to food.
- 14 Bordeaux Sauvignon Blanc, Dulong 2006 £20.00  
Pale yellow robe, delicate and elegant, with grey hues. Delicate fruity bouquet, with finishing aromas of vanilla or spices. Good balance between roundness and crispness. Pleasant lemony freshness.

#### Italy

- 15 Pinot Grigio, Ca'Lunghetta, delle Venezie, Botter 2007 £19.00  
A light and refreshing wine The elegant bouquet displays hints of ripe fruit and flowers. The palate is dry, soft and well-balanced with a full-bodied structure of ripe, refreshing fruit.

#### Spain

- 16 Blanco, Bodegas Beronia 2006 £18.00  
Delicate but vigorous, with good structure. To the palate, delightful and varied sensations of fresh fruit, notably quince and peach, with suggestions of fennel and medlar.

- 37 *Sauternes, Dulong 2004* £30.00  
Rich, golden yellow colour with a powerful and racy bouquet of beeswax and honey. Unctuous, well-balanced and persistent in the mouth with fig and apricot flavours. Ideal with foie gras, blue cheeses, white and dark chocolate or dishes made with honey.

- 38 *Champagne Mansard Brut NV* £39.95  
Blended with the three main champagne grape varieties Pinot Noir gives elegance and length, Pinot Meunier gives body weight and Chardonnay contributes aroma and finesse. There is a good amount of bottle age on the brut non-vintage, making this a very attractive Champagne.
- 39 *Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV* £85.00  
It is a gilded color, with fine bubbles and a nose of fresh fruit and hawthorn. A smooth and complex palate, with mingling fruit flavors of pear and apple, and red fruits of blackberry, raspberry and cherry, with notes of toast and almonds.
- 40 *Chardonnay, Vin Mousseux NV* £19.95  
Light, crisp, refreshing fizz from the world's most popular grape variety.
